## Human Rights and Equity Conference 2024

Over 200 BCNU members gathered in Surrey on Nov. 13 for the union's 2024 human rights and equity conference, held on the traditional, ancestral and unceded territories of the Katzie, Kwantlen, and Semiahmoo First Nations peoples. The conference's theme of inclusion encouraged members to reflect on histories and systems that are still in place today that function as mechanisms of exclusion in their workplaces and in our union.

Invited speakers included BCNU past president Debra McPherson and former BCNU provincial treasurer Mabel Tung. Both shared stories of past efforts to support social justice and build a more inclusive union, and noted achievements gained over their years in leadership at BCNU.
